

DryWind.net Interview Notes
LA Marzulli, August 2008

We initially discussed that the possibility of life on Mars or other planets not only does not conflict with the Bible, but it would make sense that God would grace his universe with biological life forms of great variety. Marzulli noted how this information will be “spun” by atheistic elements to suggest the ludicrous and illogical theory of panspermia; the idea that life on earth began as a result of transfer from another planet; which avoids the question of how life started in the first place. Marzulli noted that this model is a continuation of an atheistic agenda to remove God from the picture, even though science is demonstrating the complexity of life demands the idea of a creator.

Marzulli emphasized that a relationship with Jesus is not religion. It is a relationship with the God of the universe via the death of his son across. It is very true that many parts of organized religion and what is called “Christianity” is a world system that has very little to do with the relationship that Jesus described in the Bible.

We then discussed the recent worldwide news story about former astronaut Edgar Mitchell, who disclosed his belief that extraterrestrials were visiting the earth. One is openly hostile to the idea of discussing UFOs, and the other embraces the concept of UFOs like a religion. From these two opposing views may come a deceptive synthesis. With an increasing number of pilots, astronauts, and other qualified witnesses, the reality of strangeness in our skies is driving these two opposing camps together.

We discussed the possibility that the government itself might be allowing these leaks in the interest of slowly disclosing the reality of these craft. Against the background of this deception and confusion, He believes that the revealing of the ET presence is near. This revealing, will catch the church and most Christians off guard. However, if you read the words of Jesus, particularly in Mark 13 where he describes a situation of deception that would involve the church.

This deception will involve the “alien Gospel” which deceptively suggests that ETs are behind mankind and their religions. Marzulli notes the words of the apostle Paul, who in second Thessalonians 2:7 mentioned the “mystery of iniquity.” We note that it is clear the ET deception is part of this iniquity. The Greek word for “mystery” is to suggest a hidden thing; there are few things more confusing and hidden than the reality of fallen angels appearing as ETs.

We then discussed Psalm 2 and Revelation 17, which clearly describe the world’s governments coming against the returning Christ. I postulate that there are two deceptions occurring. The first deception suggests that the ET’s are here to save us. The second deception is that there is a mass invasion by beings from another planet. The

second deception could cause the worlds united governments to come against God and the mistaken belief that he is an invading force.

The bottom line here is the Bible is not an archaic book. The Bible describes in detail the deception that matches up with these current, strange events that are manifesting and will increase upon this earth is the time for the return of Christ approaches. It is the Church's reaction to this weird reality that is archaic. Organized Christianity is asleep on the topic of what will likely be a massive deception by the evil entity that is now in charge of the atmosphere of this planet.

With then delve into the subject that I haven't discussed in depth until this point. Science fiction and popular culture can be used both for good and bad. Both Marzulli and I have written science fiction. With that in mind, I see science fiction as a critical vehicle of propaganda for the fallen angels and regards the topic of ET's. The development of science fiction parallels the development of this deception.

With this as a backdrop we discuss how the ET as a plot line contributes to the way we view beings that are outside our normal time and space sphere. We brought up the sample of Steven Spielberg and how his work points and shapes our view of ET presence and we both agree is a deceptive manner.

Marzulli then describes the blueprint of deception. He outlines a scenario where the Middle East has become embroiled in a nuclear exchange, and the world is at its wits end with fear. In the backdrop of this fear and uncertainty a deceptive extraterrestrial presence, orchestrated by fallen Angels, could manipulate public and governmental opinion and direct the outcome, at least temporarily, for their desired end. Their goal would be to refute Jesus, God, and destroy the underpinnings of most major world religions. In the current anti-religious climate of both the West and the Communist controlled East, the morphing of religion into recognition of the ET would probably be welcomed.

The Biblical reality of this is that the book of Ezekiel Chapter 38 describes such a Middle Eastern war. The international players involved in this war are now on the scene and they are collaborating against Israel. This is a sobering reality of the vocal prophecy coming true.

While no true Christian would welcome a horrible war, the fact remains with if we believe in Jesus we should not react in fear to this reality. However it is just the sort of fear that the enemy, the evil one, will use. One can already see the tremendous popularity of apocalyptic movies. In all cases these movies point to fear, not to the redemption of Jesus.

Marzulli's scenario also includes the very real threat of a large-scale terrorist attack against the United States using a weapon of mass distraction. In combination with a nuclear exchange in the Middle East, and the world's largest free nation brought to its

knees by a terrorist attack would be an unprecedented disruption that would affect all nations of the world.

Marzulli feels that following this upheaval the fallen angels masquerading as ET's will deceptively present themselves as a solution to the problem.

We discussed the possible nature of fallen Angels with the meaning of "fallen" possibly being that they are somehow limited, or trapped, in an area that is closer to our physical existence. This limitation may explain why they manifested physical craft. I note that it is also possible that they use physical craft to carry biological lifeforms that they manipulated from existing DNA.

We clearly delineate that it is unlikely that God's angels need such craft and such physical vehicles. We also firmly stated that in no way we would ever suggest that God and Jesus manifest using ET or UFO-like technology.

Marzulli then reiterates how his book was censored at the last church he served in. It is a disturbing reality that any talk of the subject, no matter how Biblically sound, in nearly all Christian circles is pushed to the side and overtly censored.

Marzulli does note it is important not to create doctrine out of extra biblical events and texts. The Bible itself, however, offers incredible glimpses into the war that occurs between the fallen in good angels. He noted that how in the book of Daniel the "Prince of Persia" withstood the good angel until reinforcements from angel Michael came.

He describes the various incursions of these fallen Angels, and how the initial one was the strongest with the creation of the Nephilim. After the flood, Marzulli feels, there was a limitation of some of the fallen angels' power and perhaps some were limited to the earth. He feels this is why they may require physical craft, because their "wings are clipped." Subsequent manifestations occurred, including the latest one, which he feels was amplified by the Luciferic sacrifice of the Nazi Holocaust.

Marzulli notes the distinction between fallen Angels and Demons. He maintains that demons are the disembodied spirits of the Nephilim.

We reviewed how UFO flaps have tended to follow the prophetic situation in the Middle East; particularly the founding of the state of Israel area.

We review and to some degree refute the concept of an RUFO. I suggest that the spiritual world can manifest in a very physical way, and the view that the spiritual world is somehow "ghostly" is purely unbiblical. Therefore, the fact that UFOs can be very physical does not mean that they are not spiritual.

We describe how the occult practices have been growing since the 1970s, and how these practices open up doors to the spiritual realm. One such area is the United Kingdom, and

this area which is a hotbed of a cultic activity is also, not surprisingly, a hotbed of UFO activity area.

Marzulli also describes how the UFO phenomenon has been increasing, but this increase is related to an overall acceleration. This acceleration includes an increase of natural disasters and other things prophesied in the Bible in relation to the end-times.

Marzulli reviewed plans for the one-world economic system as predicted in the Bible. He feels the "Digital Angel" biochip technology may prove to be the progenitor of such systems.

Now a war looms in the Middle East as Iranians are testing EMP weapons and occupying strategic positions in the mountains overlooking Israel. Marzulli thinks this will be coincided with a terrorist attack against the U.S.

The bottom line are these prophetic events are accelerating as the Bible indicates they would.
