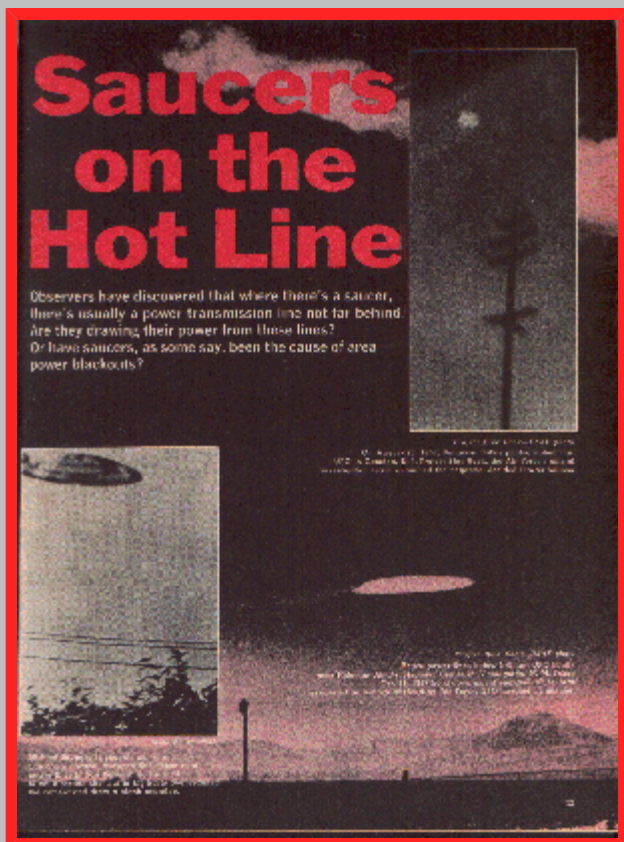

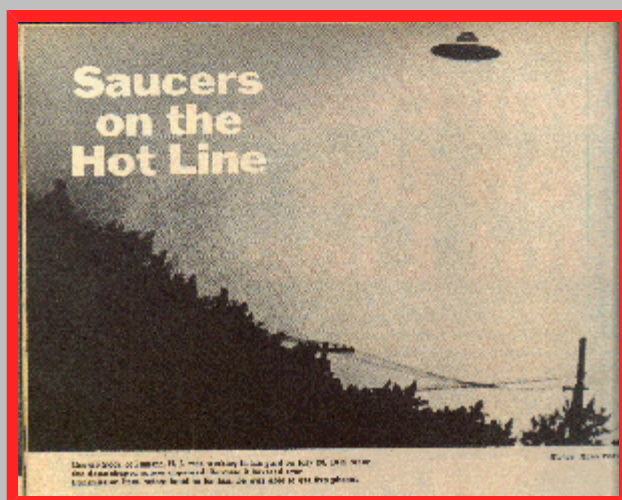

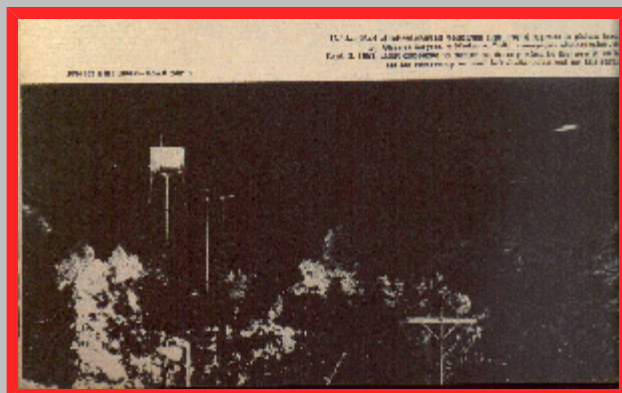

left shutter open and got this result.*

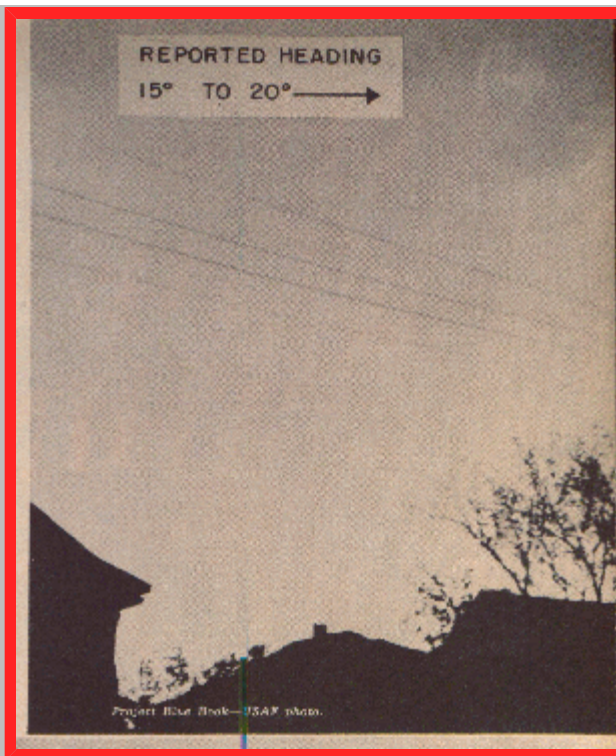
